Dear Confirmation Students and Families,

We don't need to tell you that COVID-19 has flipped the world upside down. None of us were given a handbook on how to navigate life during a worldwide pandemic. The Faith Formation team at St. Philip's has been doing our best to figure out the best way to lead confirmation during this time. This letter is to give you all an update on how we plan to go forward from here.

Our first confirmation meeting won't be until October 7, then we will meet the first Wednesday of every month after that. We will still meet at 7:30 PM. The reason we are waiting until October is because we want to give students, teachers, and families plenty of time to plan for confirmation and adjust to all the new changes. Starting school and returning to in-person worship and starting confirmation all at once -- all with new regulations to remember -- would likely be very stressful for many of us and we want to avoid that as much as we can.

Considering the fact that the previous school year ended early, all missed worship notes and service hours from that time will be excused. Starting in October, however, we expect confirmation students to resume their regular requirements. There will be an online form to fill out for students who take worship notes by watching it online.

We will be meeting in person. Students are required to wear masks and social distancethey will have assigned seats that will be kept at least 6 feet apart from each other. There will also be an option to Zoom into their class so they can attend virtually and still interact with each other from home.

It is very unlikely that we will have a confirmation this year, nor any other trips. However, we will remain hopeful that this can still be a possibility.

Lastly, we understand that living through a pandemic is stressful for everyone. It's extremely important that we support each other during this time. No matter how terrible the world gets, remember that "faith, hope, and love abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love" (1 Corinth. 13:13). God loves us and we love each other. No matter what happens, nothing can change that, and we hope that we can help our confirmation students believe that in their hearts.
