Confirmation is a special part of the faith formation journey at St. Philip's Lutheran Church. The goal of the Confirmation ministry is to acquaint our 7-9th grade young people with Jesus Christ and to establish, encourage, and strengthen active discipleship in Him. Staff, small group leaders, and parents all take part in this faith formation process which culminates in the fall of 10th grade when our students make an informed and public confession of faith in Jesus Christ as their Lord.

We encourage you to make Confirmation a top priority, a weekly commitment that enables your son or daughter to develop greater relationships with other Confirmation students, their small group leaders, and the pastors.

The year ahead promises to be exciting, challenging, and life-forming as you take part in St. Philip's Confirmation program of worship, service, class time, retreats, building relationships, and more. We look forward to growing with you.

Confirmation Curriculum

The curriculum has been designed to fulfill the promises made in Baptism: to teach the Ten Commandments, The Apostles Creed, Lord's Prayer, and the Holy Scriptures. WORSHIP

• We encourage families to attend worship together weekly.

CLASSROOM ATTENDANCE

Attend confirmation class on a weekly basis. We understand that extenuating circumstances arise
and will be taken into consideration by the confirmation leaders and make up work will be
required after 2 absences.

SERVICE HOURS AND PROJECTS

- Perform a minimum of 12 service hours within the church or within the community. Opportunities
 include choir, nursery assistant, Sunday School assistant, service projects (see below) and acolyte.
 Please see confirmation leader if you have questions regarding service hours. See your
 confirmation leader for blank forms and turn in completed forms to your confirmation leader as
 well.
- Throughout the confirmation year, you are required to attend the following service projects. These projects will count towards your service hours and will be outside of confirmation class time. See individual grade level calendars for more information.
 - o Visit Jewish Synogogue (All grades together)
 - o Volunteer at Feed My Starving Children (All grades together)
 - o Acolyting -3 times per year per student

CONFIRMATION RETREATS

- Attend one overnight 7th-9th grade retreat at Camp Victory in Zumbro Falls, MN
 - o Nov. 13th-15th

MEMORY WORK

- Memorize the following from Luther's *Small Catechism:*
 - o All ten commandments and their meanings
 - o The Apostles' Creed, and The Lord's Prayer
 - Luther's Explanation of Article 2 & Explanation of Articles 1 and 3 in the student's own words

SERMON NOTES

• Complete sermon notes on 12 worship services each year. Forms will be provided by confirmation leader.

MENTORING PROGRAM

• All students will participate in the mentoring program during Lent from February 10th – March 23rd. Mentoring information will be provided by confirmation leaders prior to Lent.

PARENTS WILL BE EXPECTED TO ...

- Attend worship regularly with confirmand.
- Make certain confirmand is on time for large group, retreats, and service projects.
- Assist confirmand in completing assignments, memory work, make-up work, and other requirements as needed.
- Attend parent-student events, service projects, and meetings.
- Attend Lent services with student.
- Attend Holy Week services with student.
- Ensure that confirmand is acolyting for 2 workship services throughout the confirmation year.
- Attend service projects with confirmand as you are able. Sign up to drive students or provide food as needed for service projects.
- Provide treats for one confirmation class throughout the year. See sign up sheet.
- Communicate concerns or special needs of confirmand to confirmation leaders, or pastors to enable them to provide the best possible program for each student.

CONFIRMATION LEADERS WILL...

- Share their faith and commitment to Christ and His Church.
- Provide the opportunity for all students to learn and grow in faith.
- Collect and keep record of service hours, projects, attendance, and sermon notes for each student.
- Encourage student's participation in large and small groups and in the church.
- Establish relationships with each student to encourage, nurture, and support your child in faith.
- Open communication to build relationships with parents, and students.

THE DISCIPLINE POLICY

- Any student who causes a disruption to his or her learning and the learning of others in the large or small groups will be **warned once** by the teacher.
- If the student continues to disrupt the program a **second time**, he or she will be asked to leave the group and spend time with the confirmation leader to discuss the situation and develop a plan for future success throughout confirmation. This plan will be signed by the student, parent, and confirmation leader.
- If the student does not follow the plan and disruption continues, the confirmation leader and student will talk to the parents. Together, they will decide how Confirmation should continue for the student.

COMMUNICATION

• Confirmation leaders will do their best to update the confirmation bulletin board in the hallway, update the confirmation webpage with current events and information, and send communication via email as needed throughout the confirmation year.
